Bill Analysis

SB 1270 creates the Oklahoma Commission on Race and Equality. The Commission shall be comprised of 10 members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Governor, and the Oklahoma Legislative Black Caucus. The first chair of the Commission shall be appointed by the Caucus with the approval of each appointing entity. The next chair shall be appointed by the Pro Tempore. Thereafter, at the first meeting of each fiscal year, the Commission shall elect a chair. Each member is limited to 3 3-year terms. Each member may be removed by their respective appointing authority. Members of the Commission shall receive no salary but shall be entitled to travel reimbursement. The Commission shall meet at least once every 3 months. The measure also creates the Oklahoma Commission on Race and Equality Revolving Fund.
