**Bill Analysis**

SB 1275 prohibits any online digital platform from selling a short-term rental without disclosing the total cost and also including the amount of sales tax the buyer is expected to pay. Such platforms are prohibited from presenting the fees and subtotals of the purchase in a font size that is larger than the font size used to present the total price. Online digital platforms may not modify the total price after the first time a price is displayed to the purchaser except when adding applicable sales taxes, relevant fees, or when the purchaser's transaction period has timed out. Violations shall be considered an unlawful business practice and shall be subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act.
