Bill Analysis

SB 1277 modifies disqualification factors for unemployment benefits. The measure replaces the requirement to apply for a minimum number of jobs with the requirement to conduct at least 3 weekly search actions. Such actions include submitting a resume, submitting a job application, attending an interview, attending a job fair, completing an online or in-person job search workshop a job search assessment, completing a career direction research or work, completing job search branding and marketing activities, participating in training, participating in job search counseling, participating in reemployment services, completing an activity with an online job search tool, taking a civil service exam, reviewing job opening suggestions, developing a complete resume in the state's employment service system.
