**Bill Analysis**

SB 1277 modifies disqualification factors for unemployment benefits. The measure replaces the requirement to apply for a minimum number of jobs with the requirement to conduct at least 5 weekly search actions. Such actions include submitting a resume, submitting a job application, attending an interview, attending a job fair, completing an online or in-person job search workshop a job search assessment, completing a career direction research or work, completing job search branding and marketing activities, participating in training, participating in job search counseling, completing an activity with an online job search tool, taking a civil service exam, reviewing job opening suggestions, developing a complete resume in the state's employment service system.
