Bill Analysis

SB 1325 requires any defendant charged with domestic abuse by strangulation, domestic abuse with a dangerous or deadly weapon, or domestic abuse after a previous adjudication for domestic abuse to have a GPS device attached to them as a condition for bail. The defendant shall pay for the cost of the device. The Department of Corrections shall monitor such defendants until the conclusion of their case. Upon application of the victim, the court may authorize the victim to monitor the location of the defendant. Such monitoring shall be limited to determining whether the defendant is within a specified distance of certain locations or the victim.
