**Bill Analysis**

SB 1328 grants parents the right to access and review their child's medical records and prohibits health professionals from restricting such access or review. The measure provides exceptions for cases where such access is prohibited by law, where such medical records are designated as privileged or confidential, or where the health professional believes that the child is a victim of abuse by the parent or that release of the records could otherwise endanger the child's safety.
