Bill Analysis

SB 1340 modifies income eligibility for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP), also known as Oklahoma's Promise. The measure states that beginning with those who apply for participation in the 2027-2028 school year, the cap will be \$100,000.00 per year based on the federal adjusted gross income (AGI) of the student's parents if they have two or fewer dependent children; \$110,000.00 per year based on the federal AGI of the student's parents if they have three or four dependent children; or \$120,000.00 per year based on the federal AGI of the student's parents if they have five or more dependent children. The measure also increases from \$120,000.00 to \$130,000.00 the cap on the federal AGI of a student's parents for a student to receive any OHLAP benefit award.
