**Bill Analysis**

SB 1348 authorizes the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission to modify the appeal filing requirements to respond to significant economic situations as well as instances where evidence suggests potential fraudulent activity or for those who have not completed the claim filing process. The measure specifies that any failure to name a codefendant in judicial actions initiated by the Commission shall result in in dismissal of the case.
