**Bill Analysis**

SB 1353 creates the Menstrual Products for Schools Revolving Fund for the State Department of Education. It allows the fund to consist of state appropriations as well as gifts, grants, donations, and bequests. The measure directs the Department to use the fund to assist school districts and charter schools in making menstrual products available at no cost in school restrooms designated for use by females or that are single occupancy.
