**Bill Analysis**

SB 1358 creates the Preserving and Advancing City and Town Transportation Fund and apportions 0.5% of the state sales tax revenue to the newly created fund. Monies from the fund shall be expended on necessary construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of municipal roads or bridges. The municipality requesting funding shall submit the proposed project to the Department of Transportation. The Department shall evaluate such proposals by examining the state of project innovation, readiness, structural adequacy, safety, serviceability, necessity for public use, structural deficiency, and special reductions for characteristics such as detour length, traffic safety features, and current school bus routes.
