**Bill Analysis**

SB 1359 increases the maximum campaign contribution an individual may make from \$10,000.00 to \$100,000.00 and also establishes this limit for all corporations, labor unions, limited liability companies, and partnerships. The measure also repeals a provision of law relating to the Ethics Commission establishing campaign contribution limits on corporations as well as Ethics Commission rules relating to campaign contributions by corporations, labor unions, limited liability companies, and partnerships.
