Bill Analysis

SB 1372 provides that any person convicted of certain crimes relating to domestic assault shall not be eligible to receive credit to reduce the person's full probation term. The measure provides that a person who completes the first year of supervised probation or the entire period of supervised probation shall receive credit equal to 1/4 of the person's probation length. Such a person shall also receive credit equal to 1/4 his or her probation length if they successfully complete an educational advancement activity. The measure requires the supervising agency to maintain records relating to such credits and to notify the court when the person receives such credit for meeting certain requirements. The measure provides for a person under probation without a supervising agency to file a motion with the sentencing court seeking a 1/4 reduction of his or her probation term.
