**Bill Analysis**

SB 1376 strikes language authorizing the Adjutant General to arm members of the state military forces on military installations and other places under the control of the Military Department. The measure authorizes the Adjutant General to define the purpose of any bequests as authorized by law. The measure provides that a soldier informed by an officer's intent to subject him or her to judicial punishment shall have 3 days instead of 45 days to provide a response if the soldier is on active duty.
