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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1380 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority conduct a search of the Social Security Administration's Death Master File and the State Department of Health's system of vital statistics when verifying eligibility to receive Medicaid funding. If the death of applicant is confirmed, the Authority shall deny the application for Medicaid funding. The measure directs the Authority to conduct a monthly death record verification for all individuals enrolled in the state Medicaid program beginning no later than January 1, 2027. The measure directs the State Auditor and Inspector to conduct periodic reviews of the Authority to ensure compliance.

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
