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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1382 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to pursue policies and programs to assist members of the state Medicaid program in preventing or delaying the onset of type 2 diabetes through the establishment of the Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP). The program shall be established within the fee-for-service and managed care delivery systems of the state Medicaid program. Contracted entities shall make the DPP available to enrolled members. Medicaid providers are authorized to recommend participation in the DPP to enrollees. DPP services shall be provided by peer coaches. Members may participate in up to 22 sessions per year. Reimbursements shall not exceed 80% of the federal Medicare program reimbursement for comparable service, billing, and diagnosis codes under the federal Medicare program. The DPP shall only be implemented if the Authority obtains federal financial participation and necessary approvals.

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
