Bill Analysis

SB 1384 creates the In-Person Absentee Voting Expansion Grant Program within the State Election Board. The program shall, subject to available funding, provide financial assistance to county election boards to establish and operate additional in-person absentee voting sites during even-numbered years. The program shall provide counties with a population that exceeds 400,000 residents with up to 6 grants to establish 6 additional sites, up to 5 grants for 5 sites for counties with a population with more than 100,000 residents, up to 4 grants for 4 sites for counties with a population with more than 50,000 residents, and up to 2 grants for 2 sites for counties with a population with more than 10,000 residents. The measure provides for the grants to be awarded in the amount of \$25,000.00 each to cover expenses related to establishing and operating 1 in-person absentee voting location. County election boards shall submit the grant application to the State Election Board. The measure also creates the In-Person Absentee Voting Expansion Grant Program Revolving Fund.
