**Bill Analysis**

SB 1403 modifies the time period an participant in the quality jobs program shall have to file a claim for payment with the Oklahoma Tax Commission from as soon as practicable to 1 year. The maximum period of 3 years is reduced to 1 year as well to conform with the new language. The measure also removes the minimum statewide wage threshold to be considered qualifying wages, requiring qualifying wages to exceed the county wage threshold.

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
