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Bill Analysis

SB 1404 authorizes the withdrawal of funding from the Revenue Stabilization Fund if the federal government is shutdown for a period that exceeds 15 days. The measure authorizes the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to withdraw up to 25% of the balance of the Revenue Stabilization Fund available at the beginning of the fiscal year. The amount withdrawn shall not exceed the amount of funding needed to pay the salaries of state employees who are either partially or fully paid by federal funds or pay for the portion of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits to individuals enrolled in the program that are reduced or eliminated as a result of the federal government shutdown. For each week beyond the 15 days, the Director shall prepare and submit a report to the President Pro Tempore, Speaker of the House, and Governor detailing the amount withdrawn, salaries paid, number of furloughed employees, and the number of SNAP enrollees that have had benefits reduced or eliminated. If the federal government provides funding for such items at the end of the shutdown, the funds shall be deposited into the Revenue Stabilization Fund.

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
