**Bill Analysis**

SB 1428 creates the Office of Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia Service Coordination within the State Department of Health. The Office shall provide statewide coordination, service system development, and information on education, support, and other available services for individuals with Alzheimer's disease or related dementias and their caregivers. The Office shall be required to maintain at least 1 dementia services coordinator, who shall be a full-time employee responsible for staffing the Office.
