Bill Analysis

SB 1442 decreases the license fee for distillers from \$3,125.00 to \$1,000.00 and creates a micro-distiller license. The micro-distiller license fee is set at \$325.00 and requires the distiller to produce no more than 2,400 proof gallons annually of spirits from any source or substance. Micro-distillers are also authorized to produce mash, wort or wash. Micro-distillers shall not be required to provide proof of insurance in the application process and shall be located outside of corporate limits of any municipality. Such distillers shall not host public tours, tastings, or events and shall be located in a stand-alone building of less than 5,000 square feet. Micro-distillers may not employ more than 3 individuals, including the owner and any contractors. The measure caps fines for micro-distillers at \$5,000.00.
