**Bill Analysis**

SB 1445 modifies criminal penalties for any person convicted of tearing down barricades or entering a closed area on a highway or road during a flood if the action resulted in a death. The measure provides such a person would be guilty of manslaughter in the first degree if he or she is under the age of 18 and guilty of manslaughter in the second degree if he or she is over 18 years of age.
