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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1447 prohibits any contract between the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan and a pharmacy benefits manager (PBM) from being awarded to a PBM that has settled a lawsuit, been fined, or had judgment against such PBM over \$4 million in the last 5 years. The measure also requires the scoring of a request for proposal to include favorable treatment for any bidder who has been domiciled in the state for at least 1 year. Scoring shall also disfavor a PBM that owns a health insurance company, retail pharmacy chain, specialty pharmacy business, mail-order pharmacy business, or pharmaceutical manufacturer.

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
