Bill Analysis

SB 1451 directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to modify voter registration forms by including a space that indicates whether a voter was previously registered to vote in another state, a space indicating the address the voter was previously registered in another state, and a statement for the voter to sign indicating he or she wants his or her previous registration cancelled. The measure requires the county election boards to transmit the information outlined in the measure at regular intervals to the State Election Board as prescribed by the Secretary. Upon receiving the registration of a voter who filled out the newly included spaces, the Secretary shall transmit the voter's request for cancellation of registration to the appropriate jurisdiction.
