**Bill Analysis**

SB 1460 classifies second and subsequent offenses relating to looking upon a person in a clandestine manner, using recording equipment in a clandestine manner, and subsequent convictions for using recording equipment in a clandestine manner as B5 offenses. Persons convicted of second or subsequent B5 offenses shall be subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 5 years and/or a maximum fine of \$5,000.00.
