Bill Analysis

SB 1467 directs criminal justice agencies to share all criminal justice data and records relating to topics outlined in the measure to bona fide researchers that agree to keep personally identifying information private, certify that approval was secured from an institutional review board, and certify that security controls are in place. The measure specifies that releasing such information to researchers shall not qualify as a release to the public for the purposes of the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The measure directs the Attorney General to issue guidance to assist criminal justice agencies in complying with the provisions of this measure. Agencies may assess reasonable fees.
