Bill Analysis

SB 1511 requires any business or person that employs a person registered pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act to post signage showing that business employs a registered offender if the business offers or provides services where children are reasonably expected to be present. Such businesses shall be required to ensure compliance by conducting a name search of employees at least annually against the registry. The measure establishes a misdemeanor for failing to comply with the provisions of this measure as well as a maximum \$1,000.00 fine.
