**Bill Analysis**

SB 1522 authorizes licensed dealers to enter into a firearm hold agreement with a firearm owner to hold or store a firearm for the firearm owner. A licensed dealer who enter into such an agreement shall not be civilly liable for damages or injuries unless such damages or injuries resulted from gross negligence or the dealer knew at the time the firearm owner sought to retrieve his or her firearm pursuant to a firearm hold agreement that the firearm owner was demonstrating behavior that he or she would engage in unlawful use of the firearm or self harm.
