**Bill Analysis**

SB 1526 authorizes limited partnerships and limited liability partnership to own retail spirit licenses in counties with a population of 70,000 or more. The measure also provides for a limited partnership to convert into a limited liability partnership at any time without the need to reapply for a license or suspend business operations, provided the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission is notified within 90 days of the conversion. Changes to the partnership must be disclosed to the Commission within 5 business days.
