**Bill Analysis**

SB 153 requires a person who is voting to sign an oath attesting that the address listed is his or her address. Any person who cannot sign the oath shall be given a provisional ballot when allowed by law. The precinct official shall provide such a voter with a change of voter registration form to update the address.
