Bill Analysis

SB 1543 provides that a conviction of a second act of driving under the influence within a 1-year period shall be classified as a Class C2 offense. The measure also provides that a separate offense within this period may be aggregated and prosecuted as a single offense. A persons convicted of this crime shall be guilty of a felony and subject to an assessment and evaluation plan in addition to other penalties as provided for in current law. A maximum fine of \$2,500.00 is also established by the measure. The measure repeals obsolete language relating to the driving under the influence.
