**Bill Analysis**

SB 1555 modifies the qualifications for designation as an individual with intellectual disability. The measure provides that an individual with an IQ of 71-75 and accompanied by a verbal or performance IQ score of 70 or below shall qualify for the designation. The measure also increases the age limit from 18 to 22 and provides that the diagnosis shall consider the Social Security Administration Listing of Impairments for disability evaluation.
