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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1559 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to conduct a pilot program to test a direct primary care model for members of the state Medicaid program. The program shall operate for a 36-month period and begin no later than 6 months after the effective date of the measure. The program shall serve a cohort of 1,000 Medicaid beneficiaries and shall use a per-member-per-month payment system for direct care primary care providers. The Authority shall directly enter into contracts with such providers with competitive bids. Providers shall be required to meet federal enrollment and quality standards. The Authority shall submit a report of the program to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor.

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
