**Bill Analysis**

SB 1561 modifies the authority of the State Commissioner of Health as it relates to licensure for the operation of an ambulance service. The measure changes “suspend or revoke any license” to impose disciplinary actions for violations and provides for the imposition of probation or requiring the provision of charitable services. The measure also authorizes the Commissioner to impose fines and penalties for violations.
