Bill Analysis

SB 1563 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to not establish more restrictive or more extensive utilization controls for any nonopioid drug approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) than the least restrictive or extensive utilization controls applicable to any opioid or narcotic drug that is FDA-approved for the treatment or management of pain. The measure authorizes carriers of state employee health plans to adopt or amend a state preferred drug list (PDL). The PDL shall not establish more restrictive or more extensive utilization controls nonopioid drugs than the least restrictive or extensive utilization controls applicable to any opioid or narcotic drug that is FDA-approved for the treatment or management of pain.

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
