Bill Analysis

SB 1611 creates the Procurement Protection Act of 2026. The measure prohibits awarding state contracts or contracts with political subdivisions to any state-owned enterprise of a foreign adversary, company domiciled within a foreign adversary, foreign adversary company, or federally banned corporation. Any company submitting a bid for a contract must certify that the company is not a company listed in the measure. If the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services or political subdivision determines that a company has submitted a false certification, the company shall be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$250,000.00, contract termination, and ineligibility to bid on other contracts for a period of 60 months. State agencies may enter into a contract with a listed company if there is no reasonable alternative and the contract is pre-approved by the Director.
