**Bill Analysis**

SB 1615 modifies the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP), also known as Oklahoma's Promise. It expands eligibility to children of certified administrators who apply for participation beginning in the 2026-27 school year. It defines "certified administrator" as someone who has been a certified, full-time superintendent or principal who has been employed as a certified classroom teacher, a superintendent, or a principal for a minimum of 10 years prior to the child applying. The measure also repeals a duplicate version of law regarding eligibility for Oklahoma's Promise.
