**Bill Analysis**

SB 1618 requires each judicial district to utilize risk assessment tools produce a risk rating that shall determine release conditions prior to the arrested person's initial appearance before a court. Consideration shall be given to the nature of the crime as well as the defendant's criminal history. The court shall base the amount of bail required based on the risk assessment. The presumption of the accuracy of the assessment tool may be rebutted if deviation from the tool is necessary to secure the appearance of the defendant, protect the safety of the person or community, or comply with a specific statutory requirement.
