**Bill Analysis**

SB 1619 requires any company seeking to build a data center on unincorporated county land to notify the board of county commissioners by submitting a notice of intent. The notice shall be read aloud and entered into the minutes of the next meeting of the board. The measure requires the company to coordinate with the board to hold 3 public meetings with at least 2 weeks between each meeting. The meetings shall take place at a convenient location within the county near the location where the individual or company intends to construct a data center. Notice of such meetings shall be published at least 2 days prior to each meeting. After the 3 meetings, the board shall approve or disapprove the construction. No vote for final approval shall take place until all members of the public who wish to comment have had the chance to express such comment.
