**Bill Analysis**

SB 1625 prohibits any bill providing for a mandate impacting the health plans from being considered by the Senate or the House unless there is an impact analysis of the bill. The determination of whether the bill possibly contains a mandate shall be made by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. Both legislative leaders may request an analysis of the bill by the Insurance Department. The Department shall prepare a written report to be returned to the President Pro Tempore and the Speaker analyzing the issues outlined in the measure. The measure authorizes the Department to contract with a third party to carry out this analysis. A copy of the report shall also be provided to the author of the bill.

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
