**Bill Analysis**

SB 163 defines coercive control as it relates to awarding guardianship of an unmarried minor. The measure defines coercive control as isolating the person from sources of support, depriving the person of basic necessities, monitoring and controlling the person's activities, compelling the person to engage in conduct from which he or she has a right to abstain, committing or threatening to commit cruelty to an animal, forced sex acts or threats, and making demands of a person to limit free will and lead to compliance.
