**Bill Analysis**

SB 1634 prohibits the State Department of Education from accepting federal funds including block grants to expand school-based health care services or implementing school-based health centers or clinics. It directs the Department to review all existing contracts and terminate any related to such services, centers, or clinics. It also directs the Department, in consultation with school districts in the state, to conduct a comprehensive compliance review of all individualized education programs to ensure any medical services provided are educationally necessary. The measure also directs school district boards of education and charter school governing boards to review all existing contracts and terminate any related to expanding services, centers, or clinics.
