**Bill Analysis**

SB 1650 requires each assisted living center to post an assisted living center bill of rights that informs each resident that they shall be shown consideration and respect, that the center shall only terminate their contract for just cause with 30 days' notice, shall have the right to present grievances and file complaints with the living center without reprisal, that the center shall contract with service providers or organizations in the community to achieve the highest level of independence for the residents, shall have the right to access requested information relating to their own record, the center shall refuse to provide information to third-parties, and they shall be made aware if a resident has contracted, arranged, or is being provided with a companion caregiver or any other provider of personal services in the resident's personal apartment.
