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Bill Analysis

SB 1654 provides that any encounter between a mobile integrated healthcare (MIH) supplier and an enrollee that results in a treatment without transport of the enrollee shall be reimbursed by a health care benefit plan at a rate not less than the minimum allowable reimbursement rate under the methodology established for the state Medicaid program. The reimbursement rate for triage provided by the MIH supplier shall be no less than the basic life support (BLS) services or advanced life support (ALS) services. The redesignates the community paramedic program as the MIH program. The measure also directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to establish a reimbursement methodology for encounters between an MIH supplier and enrollees.

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
