**Bill Analysis**

SB 1665 prohibits any court from abridging a person's right to purchase, possess, concealed carry, or open carry a firearm. The measure prohibits any court from requiring the seizure and destruction of a firearm due to a misdemeanor arrest. Unless the firearm was used during the commission of the misdemeanor, firearms must be stored and returned after a misdemeanor case is resolved.
