Bill Analysis

SB 1666 provides that a peace officer shall be liable to the injured party for legal or equitable relief or any other appropriate relief if he or she subjects an individual or causes an individual to the deprivation of any individual rights relating to firearms. The measure specifies that Governmental Tort Claims Act shall not apply to claims brought under the provisions of this measure. The measure specifies that qualified immunity shall not apply. The measure requires the employer of an offending officer to indemnify him or her for any liability incurred or for the settlement entered against the officer unless the employer determines the officer did not act in good faith. Such officers shall be personally liable for up to \$25,000.00 or 5% of the judgement or settlement, whichever is less.
