**Bill Analysis**

SB 1671 directs the State Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Wildlife Conservation, to determine the earliest grade in which students can begin receiving firearm safety. It directs each public school district and charter school in the state beginning in the 2026-2027 school year to annually provide students with age-appropriate and grade-appropriate instruction on firearm safety. It allows the State Department of Education to approve a curriculum or program of instruction if it bears a brand or stated organizational affiliation.
