Bill Analysis

SB 1680 provides that a person may carry a firearm into any structure, building, or office space which is owned or leased by a city, town, county, state, or federal governmental authority if the building has a peace officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training and a metal detector present at a security checkpoint. The building must also be used for the purpose of conducting business with the public. The measure requires handgun storage to be present outside of government buildings that prohibit carrying firearms.
