**Bill Analysis**

SB 1681 creates the Preserving Oklahoma Values Act of 2026. The measure requires any court ruling on a decision to not base its ruling on any foreign law, legal code, or system and provides that such rulings shall be void if it contradicts Judeo-Christian Western rights and values. If a contract is based on foreign laws, codes, or systems and it contradicts Judeo-Christian Western rights and values, it shall be void. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to any corporation, partnership, limited liability company, business association, or other legal entity that contracts to subject itself to a foreign law, legal code, or system.
