Bill Analysis

SB 1687 provides that a person may be issued a Class D license if a person who has been issued an intermediate Class D license for 1 year is at least 18 years of age. The measure also provides that a certified driver education instructor or designated examiner shall be permitted to proctor the knowledge written examination and will not be restricted by any identification verification or age verification system while proctoring the examination.
