**Bill Analysis**

SB 1715 requires the manual for guardians ad litem developed by the Oklahoma Bar Association to be updated and reviewed every 2 years. The measure also prohibits waiving disclosure requirements by either party when appointing a court expert in custody proceedings. The measure modifies the minimum requirements for such court experts. The measure requires such experts to have completed 6 hours, instead of 16 hours, of domestic violence training prior to appointment and to complete an additional 2 hours of annual training.
